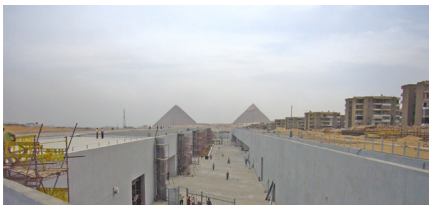
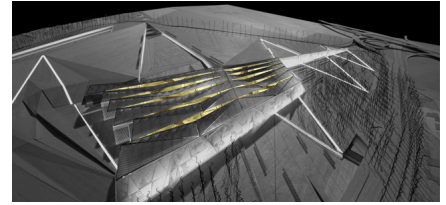
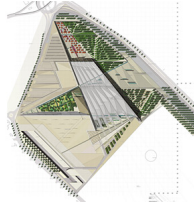


GRAND EGYPTIAN MUSEUM PARK
