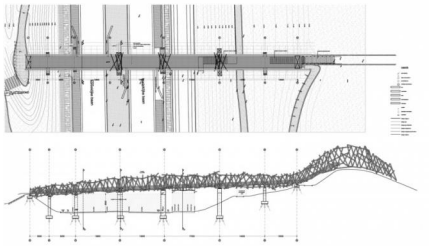
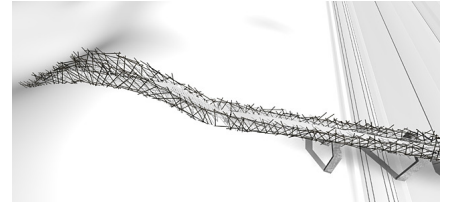
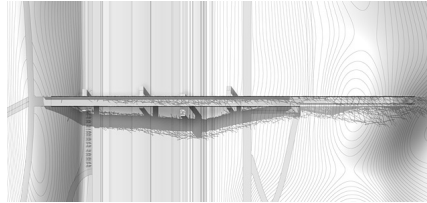
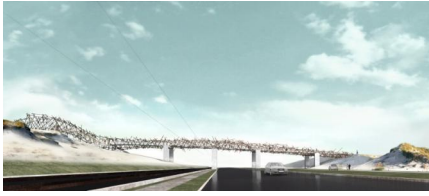


# PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE WENDUINE

The surroundings of the pedestrian bridge in Wenduine are characterized by the presence of unique cultural landscapes such as the polder, the dune area, beach, sea and recreational developments in the hinterland, the campsites. In addition to a new safe pedestrian crossing, the bridge connects to its context and forms literally a bridge between the polder and the dunes. A new dune volume provides in a natural way the access to the bridge.
